CONDITIONS

To be read prior to acceptance of invitation to exhibit

- 1. Entry Fees must accompany Registration Forms.
- NEW EQUIPMENT only may be displayed for sale. Used equipment
 may be brought on to the Reserve for demonstration purposes
 only.
- 3. The use of and/or demonstration of amplifiers, loud speakers and two way radios by an Exhibitor is prohibited.
- 4. The Secretary or an appointee of the said Field Days (Inc.) Committee shall have the power to enter upon the areas described at any time and remove any article, sign, picture or printed matter, which in their opinion may be the cause of offence to the public or officials of the Committee.
- Exhibitors hereby accept all responsibility for any damage or injury to any person, persons or property which may be occasioned by or arise out of the use of any machinery, implement or apparatus of any nature whatsoever used in connection with the stands and/or demonstrations, and Exhibitors hereby undertake to faithfully conform with the requirement of any Act of Parliament which may govern the erection of structures, displays and/or demonstration and/or sales of machinery and other products, and to also conform with any regulations, by-laws or ordinances made under such Acts of Parliament, or by any Government, Semi-Government or Local Government Authority authorised to make regulations, by-laws or ordinances in connection there with.
- All Exhibitors must have public risk insurance on their sites, and evidence of same shall be produced upon request.
- 7. Except with the written consent previously obtained from the Secretary, the Exhibitor shall not assign or sub-let or part with the possession of the whole or any part of the space or purport to do
- Security arrangements will be made by the Committee on the nights of the 10th to midday 16th of October, but the Committee shall not be held liable for any loss or damage to the Exhibitors' property whilst on the said area.
- If the Committee should find it necessary or expedient to cancel or postpone the Wandin Silvan Machinery Field Days 2017, this contract shall cease to operate upon notice to that effect, signed by the Secretary, being served on the Exhibitor by handing it to him

- personally or posting it to him in a pre-paid envelope or wrapper at his address above-mentioned or at the option of the Committee by agent or partner of the Exhibitor and the Committee shall not be liable to the Exhibitor for any compensation whether on the ground of loss of profits or otherwise in respect of such cancellation or postponement and the Exhibitor shall not be entitled to any refund or payment paid by the Exhibitor in relation to this Contract.
- The Committee expects that each stand be manned at 8.30 a.m. each day and be staffed at all times throughout the day.
- 11. All heavy equipment to be on site by 6.00 p.m. Thursday 12th October, 2017.
- 12. No vehicle (including ride-on mower or tractor) to be driven on or in walkways unless moving to or from demonstration area.
- No demonstrations of any equipment or machinery in walkways or areas other than those designated for demonstration purposes.
- Forklifts/Cranes only to be operated by fully licenced operators with correct D.L.I. endorsement.
- 15. Forklifts/Cranes will be available at times stated in prospectus.
 Unloading at other times is the Exhibitor's responsibility and this committee will not make arrangements for such unloading.
- Equipment being placed on site by crane or forklift must have approved lifting points or be palletised.
- 17. All displays are to remain in place until 4.00 p.m. Saturday. Displays must not be dismantled or exhibits removed until this time.
- 18. No digging of post holes on the Reserve or no peg is to be driven into the ground without the permission and supervision of a committee member. (To avoid damage to underground drains and underground power mains.)
- 19. The Committee reserves the right to cancel this contract and to retain any money paid in relation thereto if there is in the opinion of the Secretary any infringement of any of the foregoing conditions and/or if the Exhibitor does not occupy the space at the commencement of and during the full period of the said Field Days.
- 20. Exhibitors using cooking or heating appliances must ensure that they have a Fire Extinguisher on site at all times.
- 21. No hazardous chemicals are permitted on site.

EXHIBITOR SAFETY

- The Exhibitor shall at all times exercise all necessary precautions for the safety of the public, employees and others appropriate to the nature of the exhibit site/demonstration and the conditions under which the event is conducted, and shall comply with all statutory requirements and such directions as the Executive Officer (or nominated persons) of the Wandin Silvan Field Days may give from time to time.
- 2. Notwithstanding any directions or approvals given by the Executive Officer (or nominated persons) the Exhibitor shall at all times be held responsible for the safety of all persons engaged in the operation of an exhibit site/demonstration.
- The Exhibitor shall promptly report to the Executive Officer (or nominated persons), all accidents involving death, personal injury, and all incidents with accident potential such as equipment, structural or infrastructure failure and the like. If requested by the Executive Officer (or nominated persons), a written report shall be provided in the form directed.
- 4. The Exhibitor shall prepare and implement a site specific Safety Management Plan. This plan will demonstrate how the Exhibitor will comply with the Occupational Health and Safety Act and associated Acts and Regulations. As a minimum the plan will detail:
- 4.1. Safety management responsibilities within the Exhibitor's organisation which details the names and positions of persons responsible for the following aspects:
- 4.2 Keeping up to date with relevant OH&S Regulations, Codes of Practices and the communicating of their relevance within the Exhibitor's organisation, e.g. crane operators, forklift drivers.

- 4.3 The identification of and the evaluation of site-specific OH&S hazards.
- 4.4 Ensuring the continued operating safety of all equipment, plant and materials used on the site.
- 4.5 Procuring training, enforcement of their use and the monitoring of the condition of all related equipment.
- 4.6 The management of on-site work methods, the warning of hazards and the implementation of accident and emergency procedures.
- 4.7 The protection of the public on and near the site.
- 4.8 The assessment and monitoring of sub-contractors.
- 4.9 Providing First Aid and the maintenance of First Aid stocks.
- 4.10 The identification of the site related OH&S hazards and for each hazard, the submission of a detailed Job Safety Analysis (JSA) incorporating operational procedures designed to manage the associated hazards.
- 4.11 A mechanism for reviewing the site related hazards during the life of the Event and if necessary the development of revised Site Safety Plan
- 5. In developing the Site Safety Plan consideration should be given, but not limited to, the defining of confined spaces, adequate illumination, traffic control, machinery guards, safe access, working at heights, hazardous substances.
- 6. The Safety Management Plan is to be submitted to the Wandin Silvan Field Days Committee. If the plan, in the Executive Officer's (or nominated person's) opinion, does not adequately cover the requirements, then work will not be permitted to commence on site until the plan has been revised to incorporate these requirements.

STANDS

The Committee will mark out the Stands on Sunday 8th October to enable Exhibitors to begin setting up from Monday onwards. The Committee expects all Exhibitors to be organised and on their stand by opening time of 8.30am Friday 13th October.

DISPLAY SITES

Outdoor display sites are available on either the Front Oval (Light Machinery and General Products) or on the Rear Oval (Heavy Machinery) of the Wandin East Recreation Reserve. Fees for Display Sites include a listing in the Official Field Day Handbook, and compulsory Public Liability Insurance, taken out through the Victorian Agricultural Societies. This extends the Field Day Committee's Policy.

Sites on the Front Oval measure 5 metres frontage by 8 metre depth. (Light Machinery and General Products)
Sites on the Rear Oval measure 8 metre frontage by 10 metre depth. (Heavy Machinery Location) Undercover
Sites measuring 3 metres x 3 metres are available in the
Sporting Pavilion. Allocation of these sites will be at the
discretion of the Committee. Smaller indoor sites are
available on request. Please note that there is no Vehicular
Access to this Sporting Pavilion. General Interest Marquee
– sites measure 3 metres x 2 metres. Site fees as per
Application Forms.

POWER

The Fee for power on site is \$60.00 per Exhibitor (GST Inclusive). 240v Single Phase Power is available. Please indicate if you need power to your site. If you require more than 10 Amps, written application must be made to the Secretary with your Site Application. Drawing of more than 10 Amps without written application will mean withdrawal of supply.

(All fees quoted are inclusive of GST)

CRICKET PITCH AREA

An exclusion zone will be marked to ensure there is no vehicular traffic over or in near proximity to the Central Cricket Pitch area. This is in compliance with our local Shire of Yarra Ranges instructions.

OPERATING HOURS

The gates will open to the General Public on Friday 13th October from 8.30am to 5.00pm. On Saturday 14th October, gates will open from 8.30am to 4.00pm.

PUBLICITY

The Wandin Silvan Field Days are advertised and promoted extensively in various local and country, weekly and monthly newspapers and magazines. These generally include Southern Farmer, Weekly Times and local Lilydale & Yarra Valley Publications. Advertising on Country TV is also now a regular feature. Exhibitors are encouraged to support these publicity opportunities to maximise promotion of the event.

CATERING

Light refreshments will be available for Exhibitors setting up on Thursday 12th October at the Reserve. Traditionally, Catering is restricted to local Schools and Community Groups who will provide full catering facilities on Friday and Saturday for Exhibitors and the visiting Public. Exhibitors who may have had private catering on their stands in the past should now be aware of current strict Food Handling Regulations, and are therefore discouraged from doing so. Exhibitors are otherwise instructed that they must comply with current Regulations accordingly.

UNLOADING

A drive on/off ramp is available on site. Access is via the Northern gate to the Reserve on the Monbulk-Seville Road.

CRANE

A crane will be available free of charge at the following times ONLY:

If a crane were to be required outside these times, the fee would be negotiable between the Exhibitor and the crane operator.

LICENSES

Any person driving a tractor or vehicle at the Field Days must have a current Driver's License. Any person operating a forklift or crane must hold a current D.L.I. Operator's License.

SECURITY
